<p>A limited number of passes will be available at the BLS Library reference desk beginning Monday, May 18, 2015 at 9am. Passes are \$50.00 except for graduates of law schools that charge more than \$50.00 for summer access for BLS students. For those graduates, the charge is equal to the amount that their law school charges.</p> <p>Bring law school ID card and proof that you are taking the July 2015 bar exam. Passes may be purchased Monday – Thursday, 9am – 8pm, Friday 9am – 6pm. Payment must be by check or cash; credit cards are not accepted.</p> <p>BLS 2015 graduates and members of the BLS Alumni Association do not need passes.</p> <p>No computer lab or printing access. Wireless access guest pass available. No food. The bar study access pass is valid from May 18th – July 31st.</p> <p>- Access hours to the law library will be: Monday – Sunday: 8 am–10 pm (including holidays)</p> <p>Wireless access will be available.</p> <p>- Proof that you are taking the July 2015 bar exam will be required along with either a law school or government issued photo ID card.</p> <p>Please contact Allie Robbins, Assistant Dean for Academic Affairs - CUNY School of Law by email at allie.robbs@law.cuny.edu for registration and program information.</p> <p>Only checks and cash (exact amount only) will be accepted.</p> <p>Registration will begin on May 11, 2015 at 9 am.</p> <p>(*Note: No private study rooms or computer lab/printing access will be available.)</p>	<p>Free access will continue to be available for all Fordham Law School and Fordham University graduates, with Fordham student ID or Fordham Alumni Association card.</p> <p>Access to bar studiers who are not graduates of Fordham University or Fordham Law School will be granted under the following conditions:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - 50 bar study passes will be sold for \$50 each on a first come first served basis. - You must appear in person to purchase a bar pass (one pass per person). - The first day of sale will be Wednesday, May 20th at 8:30 am. - There are no advance reservations taken for the passes. - Payment must be in the form of a check or money order. <p>Non-Hofstra Law School graduates who are taking a bar review course at Hofstra Law School in preparation for a summer or winter bar exam must purchase passes for Bar Study Access. Fifty (50) passes will go on sale on a first-come first-served basis at NYLS, beginning on Friday, May 15, 2015 at 9 am. Proof of law school affiliation must be presented at time of purchase.</p> <p>The charge for the Reader’s Pass is \$50, except for graduates of law schools that charge NYLS graduates more than \$50 for bar study access to their libraries. In those cases, the Reader’s Pass charge is equal to the amount that their law school charges. <i>The NYLS Reader’s Pass charge is non-refundable, and lost or stolen passes will not be replaced.</i></p> <p>All students enrolled in the BarBri course held at NYLS have free Library access. Those enrolled in other bar review courses, or BarBri courses held at other locations must purchase a Reader’s Pass as described above.</p> <p>Library Reader’s Pass visitors are required to honor NYLS food and drink, and quiet study rules. <p>Patrons who wish to obtain a St. John's University Rittenberg Law Library Access Card must fill out THIS APPLICATION and present proper identification. The application can be sent via e-mail to the Law Library.</p> <p>Students attending any law school with which St. John's has a reciprocal-access agreement may be issued an access card upon presentation of current law school identification and a letter of introduction from their law school library.</p> <p>Licensed attorneys and those preparing for bar examinations may be issued an access card with presentation of government issued identification and Bar Association or Bar Review Course ID's. Patrons with these access cards may use the library collections but have no borrowing privileges.</p> <p>No access cards may be used during any exam period.</p> <p>Click HERE to see a list of local law schools that offer reciprocal access.</p> <p>Access cards do not include access to the Computer Lab or on-campus parking. Touro Law Center ID is required.</p> <p>Students from other law schools, who have graduated in 2015, and who are taking a bar review course at Touro Law Center will be permitted to use the library, beginning May 18th. Students must follow all rules of the library and the school and are considered to be visitors of the school. They are welcome to stay during regular library hours, which are listed below. They must have their student ID and proof of enrollment in the bar study course with them at all times. Wireless access is available. Computer lab is for Touro Law Center Students only.</p> <p>Snacks and drinks with lids are permitted. Cell phone conversations are not permitted. Meals are not permitted. Any violation of the noise or food policy will result in library access being revoked.</p> <p>Library Hours are subject to change, so please check our website to be certain of hours.
